

This document summarizes all the commitments made by the club and Planète Sciences in the context of space projects. Both parties are required to comply with the following commitments.

Article 1: Commitments of Planète Sciences

- Project monitoring

Clubs will be monitored remotely (by email), during the Rencontre Clubs Espace (RCE), except for projects participating in the Rocketry Challenge and via the SCAE platform (only for C'Space projects).

- Technical documents and tools

Planète Sciences provides technical documents (specifications, parachute system, telemetry, etc.) on its website, as well as technical tools (stabtraj, kiwi, kikiwi).

When a balloon is used, a reception bay for telemetry is provided. It will be brought by the aerotechnician on the day of release.

For the loan of kiwi or kikiwi, a prior request must be made to Planète Sciences. This will be honoured subject to availability.

- Campaign organization

Planète Sciences is in charge of organizing the implementation of projects: administrative authorizations, locations, personnel, security and equipment.

- Right of refusal

Planète Sciences and its partners reserve the right to refuse the implementation of a project that does not comply with safety conditions or specifications.

Article 2: Club Commitments

The club commits itself to:

1) join the Planète Sciences network. To this end, the club undertakes to:

- Complete the attached form and return it;
- To pay a contribution of 50€ to be made online with this link (<https://paiement.planete-sciences.org/auto/espace/club>) or cheque payable to Planète Sciences;
- Send the "Club Space Contract" duly completed and signed;
- Send the complete list of club members (last name, first name and email address) specifying the club's contact person;

2) to provide the updated information (e-mail address and telephone number) of a referent contact, who will be the privileged contact of Planète Sciences;

3) respect the specifications in force;

4) comply with the monitoring rules: be present at the RCEs (except for projects participating in the Rocketry Challenge), specify the desired equipment (type of propeller and type of transmitter) and respect the deadlines given by Planète Sciences;

5) return the equipment loaned within one month of the end of the project. It must be returned in good condition. If the latter is not received by August 31st of the year N+1 of the signing of the contract, the club will not be allowed to re-register for any Planet Sciences project and will incur financial penalties;

6) Have a functional recovery system (C'Space projects) for the RCE 3;

7) Provide a project report by August 31st of year N+1 even if the project has not been implemented;

8) Cite Planète Sciences and its partners on any communication medium and inform them of any media coverage.

Article 3: Financial Terms and Conditions

The annual membership fee of 50€ is valid for the whole club, from September 1st of year N to August 31st of year N+1. It gives access to all the activities of Planète Sciences.

In the event of telemetry equipment not returned or damaged (handling by the club), a financial penalty of 500€ will be charged to the club.

Planète Sciences covers travel to the NCEs on the basis of a second class round-trip train ticket for 2 members per project.

The financial situation must be regularized before projects are implemented. Otherwise, Planète Sciences reserves the right to refuse the club's visit to the event.
